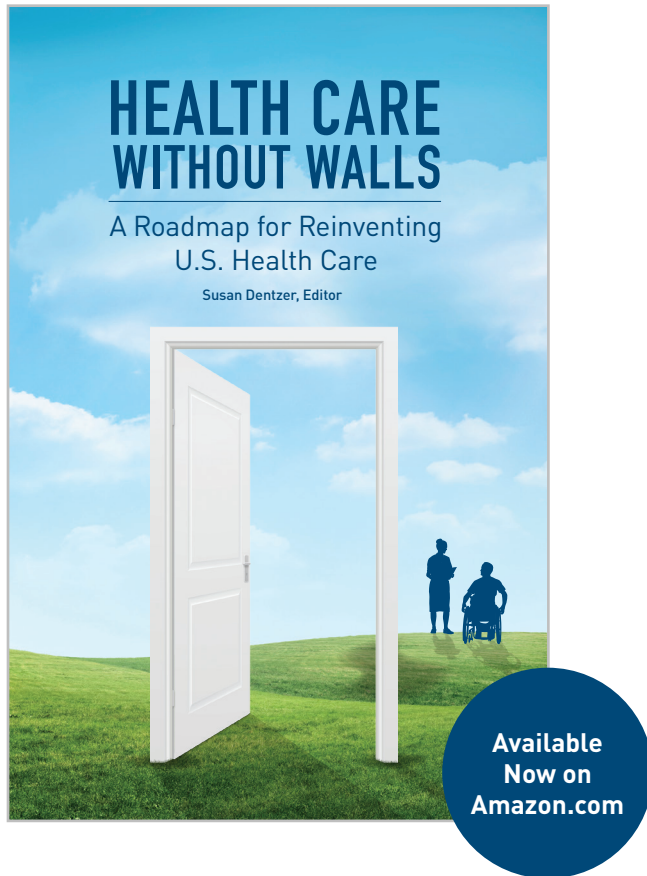


IMAGINE A HEALTH CARE SYSTEM THAT...
